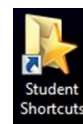


Student Guide Pearson SuccessNet

Accessing Classes on Pearson SuccessNet or SuccessNet Plus

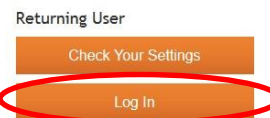
1. Sign in using the **Pearson Successnet** shortcut in the desktop folder



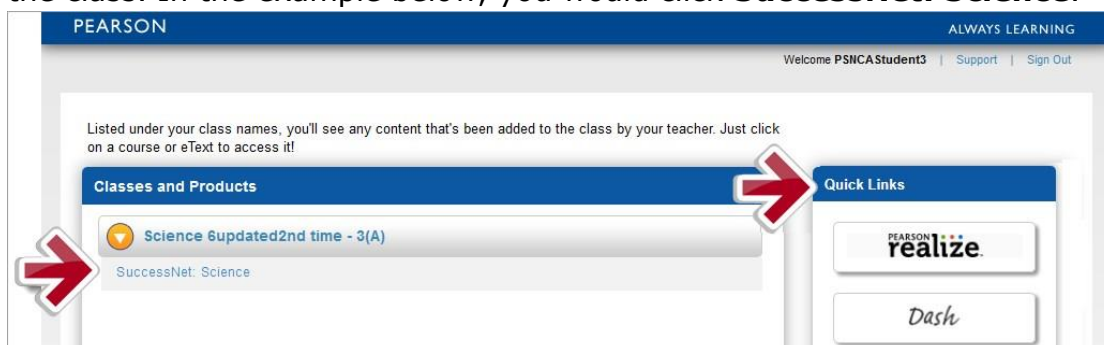

2. **For a student to login successfully, the computer must be logged in with a school-based student account.** If the computer is logged in as a teacher, the computer recognizes the teacher's network credentials and goes to Pearson as the teacher.
3. Secondary student's, who are logged into a district computer with their network login use their district network credentials as Username, Password, i.e. StudentID (Example 10101) and password (yyyymmdd).
4. Elementary or secondary students on a computer logged in with a generic student login, or from home use the following credentials; Username **INST\studentID** **OR** **studentID@student.myscps.us** and Password (yyyymmdd).
5. Click on Pearson Courses
6. Click the gold circle next to the class name to view the online curriculum used with the class. In the example below, you would click **SuccessNet: Science**.




Signing Out

To securely sign out: For each open browser tab or window, click **sign out** and close the tab or window.

Signing in to the eText for Schools App (iOS and Android)

To access the *eText for Schools* app, students should first download the app onto their device. Then, do the following steps:

1. Open the eText app.
2. Click the integration icon. 
3. Type the name of your district in the search box and select it from the drop-down list. Click **Go**.
4. Sign in using your username and password. Titles that appear on your bookshelf are determined by the courses your teachers have associated to their classes.
